# 2021–22 SEASON

## OUTLINE OF SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

### **17/5–15/8/2021**

Summer season: age-specific summer training programme, summer camps, holiday periods according to age-specific activities.

### **16/8/2021–15/5/2021**

The official sport season: training, competitions, tournaments and camps, as well as other events, holiday periods and public holidays according to age group following the club's policy.

### **Seuraleiri**

On 20–22/8/2021 in Kisakallio. The club camp is directed at players born during the 2003–2012 season as well as for Unified teams.

### **Free HNMKY trial**

Under 12-yr olds can participate in basketball practices as part of their free trial in September. Dates will be specified in August.

### **Autumn holiday (syysloma)**

Depending on the circumstances and availability, a separate programme may be implemented.

### **Autumn holiday camp (syysloma)**

Day camp activities for younger age groups.

### **Christmas break**

All HNMKY team activities will be on break during Christmas holiday 22–27/12/2021. After that, practices will be organised within a separate training programme. Regional teams (born in 2010–2016) go on holiday from 22/12/2021 to 9/1/2022

### **Winter holiday**

20/2–26/2/2022 (week 8), normally there is no team training, camp activities will be available by age group.

### **May**

Depending on circumstances and availability, a separate programme or training break may be implemented.

### **Season-ending event**

Provisional date Tuesday 17/5/2022

## 2021–22 SEASONAL FEES

### Uniform deposit

All junior players must wear the HNMKY uniform assigned and owned by the club, which is available in exchange for a deposit, in all league games of the Basketball Association. Uniform deposit: We will charge €85 in the first membership fee invoice. All junior players whose team/training group will participate in any games organised by the Basketball Association must pay the deposit. Players will pay the uniform deposit only once and it will be returned to the player in exchange for a well-maintained uniform. The uniforms are the property of the HNMKY club and if needed, players will receive a uniform of a suitable size. Uniform may only be used in HNMKY games.

### Invoicing schedule and policies

- The 2021 membership fee for the Association will be invoiced on the due date, 15/6/2021 (€40)
- Summer training fees charged according to age group will be invoiced on the due date, 15/6/2021.
- Membership fees (+2% for the 2021-2022 season) will be paid in eight or four instalments, not as a monthly fee
- Membership fee instalments (8) will be invoiced between August and March. The invoicing date is the 15th day of each month and the payment term is 14 days
- Membership fee instalments (4) will be invoiced in September, November, December and March. The invoicing date is the 15th day of each month and the payment term is 14 days
- We recommend using e-invoicing. Instructions: <https://help.myclub.fi/member/invoicing/e-invoice> (in Finnish)
- If a player drops out, the basketball office must be notified at <https://www.hnmky.fi/urheilu/koripallo/koristoiminta/lopettaminen> via the available online form. When a player drops out, they are liable to pay one membership fee instalment, i.e., when the termination notice is received, we will invoice the current and following month's membership fee instalments. Players are entitled to participate in team activities during the paid period.
- There may be some team-specific differences in the invoicing schedules due to possible training group distributions. In such cases, the club will inform each team separately.

## MEMBERSHIP GRANTS AND APPLYING FOR THEM

### Sibling and family discount

If two or more children from the same family regularly participate in the sports activities organised by the Helsinki NMKY, they can apply for a sibling discount.

The amount of the sibling discount is equivalent to the last membership fee instalment per child starting from the second child. For invoices consisting of two instalments, it is equivalent to 50% of the last instalment. Oldest children always have to pay 100%. The sibling discount only applies to those participating throughout the season and must be requested by sending an e-mail to [nea.myllyla@hnmky.fi](mailto:nea.myllyla@hnmky.fi)

Families where at least 3 children (1 adult and at least 2 children OR 2 adults and at least 1 child) are enrolled in sports activities are eligible for a family discount. The family discount is €15 for each adult, in addition to which families with at least two children engaged in regular sports activities are entitled to a sibling discount. ### Refunds for longer absences

In situations where a member's activities are interrupted due to an accident or long-term illness, they will be liable to pay one membership fee instalment as compensation. In the event of an accident or illness, please contact the club.

Apply for a refund by e-mail at [nea.myllyla@hnmky.fi](mailto:nea.myllyla@hnmky.fi) and by sending a medical certificate or a written statement to the club's sports office at: HNMKY/kausimaksuhyvitykset, Siemenkuja 3, 00700 Helsinki. The refund will be calculated in proportion to the membership fee for that season. If a player participates in the team's training during their injury period, for example in the form of gym training, or is otherwise partially involved in the training, they may be entitled to a partial refund or compensation for this period, depending on the nature of their injury.

### Financial support for membership payments

You can apply for financial support for the coming season as of 16/8/2021 in the following way:

- Applicants must fill in an application form for financial support and attach the requested information \*. The application form is available on HNMKY's website: <https://www.hnmky.fi/koripallo/tuen-hakeminen>
- Grant applications must always be made beforehand and not retroactively.
- You can apply for grants throughout the year and for shorter periods, not just the entire season or half a season.
- In the case of changes in a player's economic situation due to unexpected factors, applications may also be processed at other times.

\* In order to complete the grant application, applicants must first be prepared to find out whether they are eligible for financial support from the City of Helsinki's social services that could cover the costs of their sports activities.

Criteria for awarding a grant:

- You can only apply for a grant for one term at a time and the grant amount depends on the proven need for the grant, the number of received applications and the available financial resources, meaning that grants may vary from year to year.
- These resources are aimed at supporting households struggling with a low income or other financial challenges.
- The primary goal of our grants is to enable everyone who is interested in HNMKY's sports activities to have the opportunity to engage in their desired sport to the extent of their level of motivation.

In addition:

- If, after the grant has been awarded, irregularities are detected in the application process, or it is determined that incorrect information has been provided in the application process, the club has the right to cancel the awarded grant and recover any such grants that may have already been paid out.
- The club reserves the right to change their grant awarding policy.
